Gary E. Johnson is the first Governor in the history of New Mexico to be elected to two consecutive four-year terms. He is a Republican, self-made businessman, family man and accomplished triathlete. While in office Governor Johnson has reduced taxes, advanced school choice, and limited state government growth to around four percent after previous years of double digit growth. He has bicycled five times across New Mexico to promote fitness and litter clean up, and run 25 miles in army boots and military fatigues with a 35-pound pack through White Sands Missile Range to commemorate the WWII Bataan Death March.
